The support and encouragement shown to me by all members led to my decision to become a committee member .

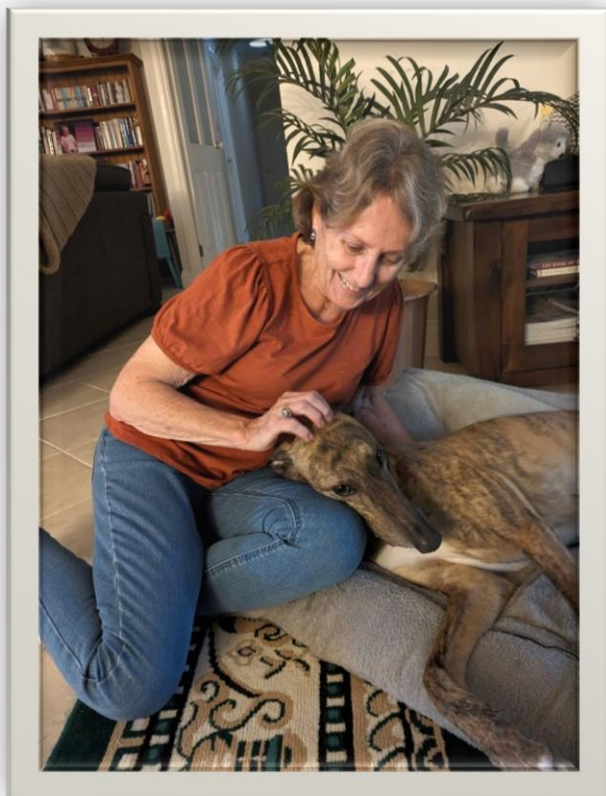
In my past life (pre golf and bridge)
