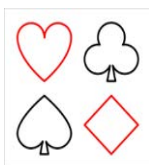

CONDUCT AT THE BRIDGE TABLE

Overall, most bridge players are considerate people. However, a constant comment to the Directors is that some people can be overheard discussing hands with their partner while still at the table.

Please save your comments for the end of the session and for your partner to hear, not most of the room.

Also, there is a need to play to time, so any discussion slows play down. This goes for offering unsolicited advice at the table. For starters, it's not very good advice if it slows down the room and players have to be given an average as they couldn't complete their boards in time. If a player wants your advice please offer it later, just not during play.

Lastly. Please keep equity at the table. Any issues, **CALL "DIRECTOR PLEASE"** before any discussion takes place.
