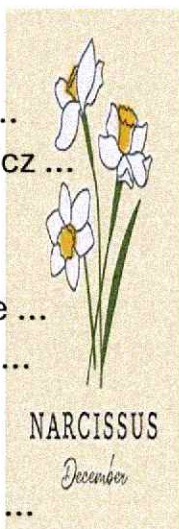

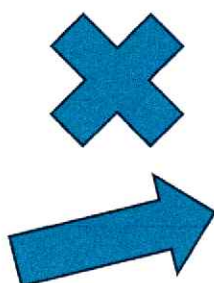
Turn RIGHT at the lights. Stay in the right-hand lane and when you come to the next set of lights (3 streets away), make a RIGHT TURN.

That is the Anglican Church.

The church has its own car park and the entry is TYRRELL STREET, which is a little street between the church and Brooke Avenue Public School.

You will also be able to see the signs for the OP SHOP on your right so you will know you are in the right place.
